BUT, in the case of your "Passing..." prompts a constant train of my own thinking in memorium paralleling yours — Bravo!

Yes, we are having a get together of a number of film-makers here the last weekend of June. I was frankly surprised that so many responded to this invitation which they must ENTIRELY pay for themselves -- i.e. we have NO grant nor any other kind of assistance except the inexpensive (relatively inexpensive) use of C.U. facilities. As there is only one weekend, we did have to severely limit the number of people who can come (about 20) so that every film-maker would have an hour for his/her showing and talk: and we are entirely filled-up for this summer's event; but it looks like we'll attempt to do this next summer also: and you will surely be invited . . . (I assumed you couldn't come this year anyway because you were/are out-of-the-country).

So, I'll look forward to seeing "Opening Series", perhaps next summer then? As for myself, I'm so broke now I'm only shooting-and-running-Orig. (which I'll be showing these summer sessions and which can ONLY be seen when I'm projecting -- i.e. such as these summer sessions and in my home: my new work, then, is so carefully balanced as original that it could never be effectively printed: I sent one of these to Erkki many months ago; and I'm wondering if he ever got it because I haven't heard from him about it: would you ask him to let me know if he received my little Original Fidom okay in the mail? . . . I'm naturally somewhat worried about it).
